Sheltered would also like to note that it was one of the first to respond to calls at 9:16 a.m. on Tuesday, August 6, 2024, to assist with displaced persons from the City's sudden closure of the Executive Inn shelter; transitioning affected individuals into alternative shelters as needed and physically assisting with their move.

Sheltered remains devoted to its mission and will continue to serve the underprivileged and those facing homelessness in Clark County to the best of its ability.
